
## **Scott Mebane Mill Historic Opportunity**

Strong Alamance County Location: This well positioned property is located outside of active, downtown Graham. Graham is the county seat of Alamance County and has an concentration of governmental and legal uses. Though a small town of 14,000 persons, Graham is immediately adjacent to the populous city of Burlington (which is the 17<sup>th</sup> largest city in NC with a population of approx. 50,000 persons) and near the I-40 / I-85 thoroughfare.

Immediate Area: This opportunity is directly across Harden Street from the pending historic redevelopment of the 1880's Oneida Mill. Oneida Mill is to be converted to 70+ multi-family units with initial construction to begin in mid / late 2015. Within blocks of this building is downtown Graham, which allows for walkable access to retail amenities, county governmental offices, and other non-residential uses / users.

Space Layout: This property is currently mostly open space with a small office component. This building could easily be built out to suit any users need. Potential Uses: Versatile building that could be developed into a small multi-family project, office / retail space, or otherwise.
